Melton Veteran Benefits

Melton has found several ways to show appreciation and aid our Veteran OTR drivers. Below is a glimpse of some of the fantastic benefits we utilize to support these brave men and women.

- Melton offers a 24-month apprenticeship program through the VA, which allows veterans access to their military benefits.
- During orientation, we honor the Veterans in the class by presenting them with Melton Military Challenge Coins.
- Provide "Military Pride" decals at our shops, to showcase military appreciation and pride OTR.
- We offer the opportunity to be selected as a driver of our wrapped Military trucks that we offer to Veterans through contests as trucks are available.
- Dynamic Veteran Resource Group made up of veterans from multiple areas within the company that work closely with our veterans to provide support and mentorship.
- Unlike many other carriers, we have specialized military recruiting professionals that are ready to help you transition into a successful flatbed career.

Veteran Pay

Melton is proud to offer former military members and active duty reservists the opportunity to use their GI Bill® benefits while enrolled in our 24-month apprenticeship program for veterans, recognized by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs and the Department of Labor.

The program is based on the Basic Allowance for Housing (BAH) in Birmingham, AL. Any GI Bill® eligible person with less than 20 months of driving experience could be eligible for this program.

Veterans with qualifying driving MOS's could qualify for an additional 6 cpm in starting pay.

- Veterans with GI Bill® benefits and no driving experience can receive BAH starting at \$1,782 per month from the VA over his/her first two years at Melton, on top of our Melton pay package.
- Veterans with 19 months of experience and GI Bill® benefits could still be enrolled for five months to complete the program and receive up to an additional \$713 per month in BAH from the VA.

Frequently Asked Questions

If you have additional questions, please reach out to our Military Recruiting Team.

Q. How do I enroll into the Military Apprenticeship Program?

A. You will receive a Military Brief during phase 2 of training with detailed instructions on the application process.

Q. Do I still qualify for the Military Apprenticeship Program without GI Bill® Benefits?

A. To qualify for the program, you must have remaining GI Bill® Benefits.

Q. Do I get credit for my military driving experience?

A. Driving MOS's typically qualify for an additional \$0.06 CPM, however, we are happy to discuss any tractor-trailer experience from any MOS.

Q. How do I ensure that I get home for my reserve training?

A. You must communicate your training schedule with your driver manager. *Communication is key* to help your DM get you to training when you need to be. Your hometime won't be impacted.

Q. How can I be selected to receive a military-wrapped truck?

A. When a new military wrapped truck becomes available, we will notify our veteran drivers via multiple channels to receive the opportunity to submit your nomination.
